Breakdown Company A - Directed by Ruff Yeager

Trash! The Musical by Naomi Melville – Trash jumps out of the can to find its purpose in this heartwarming musical.

TRASH – A collection of papers that were thrown away. Optimistic and good at inspiring hope.

RUSTY – A rusty trash can attached to several others. Cynical and irritable.

TEXAS – A broken calculator. Cheerful and optimistic.

DOLLY – An old torn up ballerina doll. Her hair is chopped off very short, and her clothes are ratted and worn.

WRITER – An aspiring yet unsuccessful writer, probably a college student.

Just Let Me Help by Marco Herrera & Chris Johnson – Financial difficulties are exposed when a father and son go camping.

FATHER – Single father, had son at an early age. Poor but does back-breaking work to keep son in school.

SON – 16 years old; Straight A student, worried about his dad, wants to get a job to help out his father.

Sea of Fog by Jack Ventimilia – Two outsiders struggle to understand religion in a modern world.

DENISE – 17 years old; Religious young woman who puts on a tough exterior to hide the fact that she can't be normal DAXX - 17 years old; Sensitive young man who's failing school, and has an incredibly rocky home life.

A Mother's Mother by Emma Kuli – A teen's pregnancy reveals the true bond between mother and daughter.

BILLIE – 17 years old; She was the perfect daughter...and then she was very pregnant

MOM-35 years old; Fiery, stubborn, and familiar with Billie's teenage pregnancy struggles

Have Hope by Shyla de Hoop - Two cats embark on a journey to find their missing mother.

HOPE – A female cat, 6 days old.

FAITH – A female cat, 6 days old. Sister of Hope.

JAY – A male cat, 4 days old.

MARY – A female cat, 5 years old. Mother to Hope and Faith.
